Directions to Liberty University:

From East (Richmond, Norfolk): Take Route 460 W to Lynchburg; Take Candlers Mountain Rd exit and go straight on Evans Blvd. Turn R on LaHaye Ct and follow signs to LaHaye Student Union

From North (Charlottesville, Alexandria): Take Rte 29 South to Lynchburg, Exit on Route 29S/460W toward Lynchburg/Danville; Take Candlers Mountain Rd exit and follow directions above

From West (Roanoke): Take Route 460 East to Lynchburg; Take Candlers Mountain Rd exit. Turn R on Candlers Mountain Rd and cross back over the highway. Then turn L on LaHaye Circle an L again on LaHaye Ct. Follow signs to Student Union

From South (Danville, VA, Greensboro, NC): Take Route 29 North to Lynchburg; then take Route 460 East and follow directions above from Roanoke.

General Info:

- Twirlers from ALL organizations are welcome to participate in any Twirling Unlimited event. There is no membership fee or special requirement. Gymnastics moves are allowed; time limits cover all organizations.
- Twirlers from all states & any twirling organization are welcome to participate in open events & MissTwirlFest.
- Twirlers from any state except ME, NE, MA and AZ are welcome to participate in the **Commonwealth Games** of **Virginia** (these states have baton twirling in their own State Games).
- No flash photography is allowed, and any video taping must be of your child only!
- Building owners, contest officials and contest sponsors are not responsible for losses, accidents, or injuries.
- NO SMOKING allowed anywhere on school grounds.
- There is no admission fee charged at the door. However, we ask that each contestant pay a facility fee of \$10.00 (added to entry form) (Maximum of \$15 per family) to help defray costs.
- Concessions will be available for purchase all day. With the exception of judges and contest officials, no one
 will be permitted to bring food or drink into the gym area.

(Twirlers should enter using their age as of the day of the competition. No double-entering for Games events).

INDIVIDUALS

Nov., Beg., Int., & Adv. Strut - Age Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

(March Music, No specific floor pattern (X strut, straight line, or freestyle) - Time limit: 2 minutes max.)

Special Beg. Basic March— Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Has not won TWO 1st places in Basic March)

Beginner Basic March – Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March in a square

Advanced Basic March - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March in a square

Sp. Beg, Beg. & Adv. Military March – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics and for classification definitions.

All Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo – No more than 1 spin/2 elbows; no toss illusions Time: 1 to 2 min.

Level 2 (Novice) Solo – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: I ½ to 2 min.

Level 3 (Beginner) Solo - No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.

Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min

Level 5 (Advanced) Solo - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.

Boys Solo – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.

Beg., Int., Adv. 2 Baton Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time Limit 1½ to 2 minutes) (continued on back)

3-Baton Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit ½ - 2 minutes)

Duet Twirl - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (avg. ages) March Music - Time: I ½ - 2 ½ minutes

Solo Dance Twirl - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Use own music; dance with one baton only; Time: 1½ -2½ min.

New! Beg & Adv Solo Show Routine - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Use own music; dance with baton & novelties; Beg Time: :30-2 minutes Adv. Time: 1½ -2½ minutes

Duet Show Routine-Use Own music; dance with baton (novelties optional) Time: 11/2-3 minutes Use avg. ages

GROUPS

Ages: Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9); Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15+)

All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-10 members); Large (11+ members)

Dance Twirl - Use own music; one baton per member; no props or novelties; 1½-3 minutes

Twirl Teams – Standard march music provided; 1 ½ - 3 minutes

Duet Strut & Strut Teams – Use own music; 1 – 3 minutes

Novelty/Show Teams – use some equipment instead of, or in addition to one baton; Own Music; 1½ - 3 min.

Pom Teams – Use own music; 1 ½ to 3 minutes

Production Groups: 10 members minimum; 5- 9 minutes

Corps: Floor, Street Parade, and Mini – 10 members minimum (See www.twirlingunlimited.com for specifics) Virginia HS Majorette Squad State Championships (must attend a VA HS to enter) - Any baton or props; 2-4 mins

OPEN EVENTS (contestants may double-enter Open Events if they wish)

PAGEANTS: (All levels: Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over)

BEG., INT., and ADV. MISS TWIRLFEST (Classification determined by solo level)— 3 part

competition. Contestants will compete in Costume Model (Best Appearing), Solo Twirl, and Strut.

BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT – 3 part competition open to Level 1 and Level 2 (Spec. Beg. & Novice)

twirlers only. Contestants will compete in Costume Model (Best Appearing), Solo Twirl, and Basic March

SOLOS: (All Girls Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+; Boys Solo 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+)

Nov., Beg., Int, & Adv. Strut – (No specific pattern (X-Strut, straight line, freestyle) – Time limit: 2 min. max)

BASIC & MILITARY MARCH (Ages same as Commonwealth Games marching)

Sp. Beg., Beg., Adv. Basic March; Sp. Beg, Beg. & Adv. Military March

COSTUME MODEL (Best Appearing)

Beg. Costume Model (Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+); Adv Costume Model (Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14 15+)

Order of Events:

Costume Model, Pageant Costume Model, Basic March, Pageant Basic March, Military March, Solo & Duet Show Routine, Teams, HS Majorette Squads, Corps, (Awards Ceremony)

Strut, Pageant Strut, Solos, Pageant Solos, 2-Baton, 3-Baton, Duet Twirl (Awards Ceremony)

Awards:

<u>Open Awards</u>: A system of flexible awards will be used. For divisions with 3 contestants or less: 1st place trophy, 2nd & 3rd place medals. 4-7contestants: 1st and 2nd trophies, 3rd place medals. 8-10 contestants: 3 trophies. 11-14 contestants: 1-3 trophies, 4th & 5th medals. 15-20 contestants: 1-5 trophies.

Pageant Awards: 1-3 Medal for Model, Strut, Twirl; 1-3 Trophy for Overall; Banner & flowers for winners

Commonwealth Games Awards:

Teams: Gold, silver and bronze neck medallions for each 1st - 3rd place team member

All individual events, all levels: Gold, silver and bronze neck medallions

Entries: Forms must be post-marked by **March 20, 2017**; Online, Phone or FAX entries accepted through **March 23, 2017 at 5:00pm**.
