Virginia Commonwealth Games to host Disc Golf & Adult Tennis – THIS WEEKEND

The Virginia Commonwealth Games, organized by Virginia Amateur Sports (VAS), is excited to host two events on June 20-21. Sports being held this weekend include:

- Disc Golf – Hosted at Duncroft Park, Gillies Creek Park, True Timber, and Dorey Park in partnership with River City Disc Golf and the Tour de Richmond
- Tennis (Adult) – Hosted at E. C. Glass High School, Lynchburg

For 37 years, the Virginia Commonwealth Games have provided excellent opportunities for thousands of Virginians to develop and foster new relationships, establish new goals and personal bests, while learning teamwork, sportsmanship, and individual team responsibilities.

Planning for the 2026 Games is well underway, and registration is officially open. This year marks the first Games hosted in the Richmond Region, which will serve as home to the event from 2026 through 2028. The region's central location and diverse facilities will help better serve athletes of all ages, abilities, and backgrounds. The move represents a significant step forward in expanding participation and strengthening the Games' impact statewide.

The Main Games Weekend is scheduled for July 24–26, 2026, and athletes from Virginia and beyond are encouraged to register early for one of the Commonwealth's largest annual multisport festivals.

The next event in the Richmond area for the 2026 Games is Wrestling, taking place June 27th at Benedictine Preparatory School.

The NCSG also oversees the **State Games of America**, a national Olympic-style event featuring medalists from State Games programs across the country.
